

Current Structure of Teaching and Training*

Hours: varying between	30 and 120
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Lectures:	60% - 70 %
Seminars / Workshops:	10% - 20 %
Bedside Teaching:	10% - 20 %

Overload of front lecturing / no immediate available materials to prepare for upcoming lecture / no sufficient lecture related material for recapitulation and self testing

Less time to see patients at bedside training

Less time focusing on important and rare diseases

Recommendation of Teaching hours for the Undergraduate Training in Dermato-Venereology**

Hours: min 60

Lectures:	40% - 50 %
Seminars / Workshops	20% - 30 %
Bedside Teaching:	20% - 30 %

Less exposure for front lecturing / immediate available materials to prepare for upcoming lecture / sufficient lecture related material for recapitulation and self testing

More time to see patients at bedside training and to deepen knowledge in important and rare diseases in seminars or workshops
