

### Current Structure of Teaching and Training\*

**Hours: varying between 30 and 120**

<b>Lectures:</b>	<b>60% - 70 %</b>
<b>Seminars / Workshops:</b>	<b>10% - 20 %</b>
<b>Bedside Teaching:</b>	<b>10% - 20 %</b>

**Overload of front lecturing / no immediate available materials to prepare for upcoming lecture / no sufficient lecture related material for recapitulation and self testing**

**Less time to see patients at bedside training**

**Less time focusing on important and rare diseases**

### Recommendation of Teaching hours for the Undergraduate Training in Dermato-Venereology\*\*

**Hours: min 60**

<b>Lectures:</b>	<b>40% - 50 %</b>
<b>Seminars / Workshops:</b>	<b>20% - 30 %</b>
<b>Bedside Teaching:</b>	<b>20% - 30 %</b>

**Less exposure for front lecturing / immediate available materials to prepare for upcoming lecture / sufficient lecture related material for recapitulation and self testing**

**More time to see patients at bedside training and to deepen knowledge in important and rare diseases in seminars or workshops**
